



**RN-to-BSN Program Benchmark Data (Updated 08/06/2021)**

The RN-to-BSN Program reports current benchmark data related to expected levels of achievement (ELAs) on specified criteria for the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing.

Criterion 6.2 The program demonstrates evidence of graduates’ achievement on the licensure examination.

Criterion 6.2 does not apply as the program is a post-licensure (RN-to-BSN) program.

Criterion 6.3 The program demonstrates evidence of students’ achievement in completing the nursing program.
