

RN-to-BSN Program Benchmark Data 2022-2023

The RN-to-BSN Program reports current benchmark data related to expected levels of achievement (ELAs) on specified criteria for the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing.

Criterion 6.2 The program demonstrates evidence of graduates' achievement on the licensure examination.

Criterion 6.2 does not apply as the program is a post-licensure (RN-to-BSN) program.

Criterion 6.3 The program demonstrates evidence of students' achievement in completing the nursing program.

ELA: 70% of FT students will graduate within six semesters (150% of anticipated length of program)

ELA: 70% of PT students will graduate within nine semesters (150% of anticipated length of program)

Graduates Employment Data

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Criterion 6.4

The program demonstrates evidence of graduates' achievement in job placement.

Expected Level of Achievement: 90% of students will have employment in nursing at time of graduation.

Rationale: Because of the nature of the RN-to-BSN Program, it is anticipated that most students will be employed at least 20 hours per week as a registered nurse. Class discussion is enriched by the diverse work experience of students at this level of education.
