

Campbellsville University is a widely acclaimed Kentucky-based Christian university that offers over 100 programs including doctoral, master, bachelor, associate and certificate programs.

CU is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges to award the certificate, diploma, associate, baccalaureate, masters and doctoral degrees.

Additional accreditation is held for the School of Business, Economics and Technology, the School of Education, the Carver School of Social Work, the School of Nursing and the School of Music.

Campbellsville University Online hosts over 90 fully-online programs. CU Online has provided online distance education since 2001.

Campbellsville University is a member of NC-SARA and KY-SARA allowing for across state reciprocity.

Any student earning an associate's degree will be guaranteed admission toward a CU Online bachelors' program with no application fee.

CU will provide a \$1500 one-time transfer scholarship to KCTCS students applying for undergraduate degree programs.

Before registering for courses, a tailored course roadmap will be provided, highlighting the most efficient path to achieving your bachelor's degree. A transfer evaluation will precede registration to maximize credit transfer, ensuring students receive the greatest possible credit toward their degree.

Students are eligible to transfer up to 72 credit hours from a regionally accredited junior or community college towards any bachelor's degree. Additionally, up to 24 credit hours may be applied towards a degree based on military training and experience.

## **Admission Requirements**

To apply as a transfer:

- Complete the <u>Campbellsville University Application</u>
- Provide official college transcripts for each institution attended reflecting all coursework attempted or earned. Only credits from regionally accredited institutions will be accepted.
- \*Students who have earned 23 hours or fewer of college credits after high school graduation must also provide a final high school transcript
- Students must have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.

## **Graduation Requirements**

A candidate for a degree must meet the following requirements for graduation:

- 1. All candidates must complete a minimum of 120 semester hours of academic work with a minimum standing of 2.10 in the area of concentration, or in majors and minors, and a minimum overall average of 2.0. "D" grades are not acceptable in <a href="ENG 111">ENG 111</a> or <a href="ENG 112">ENG 112</a>. No "D" grade is accepted in area or major and minor programs unless approved by the division chair.
- 2. Students seeking teacher certification must have an overall 2.75 cumulative grade point average.
- 3. All candidates must have completed all general education requirements.
- 4. All candidates must have completed one major and one minor or an area as specified by the Division or School applicable in each case. In combination, a major and minor must total 51 hours, exclusive of courses in methods.
- 5. All candidates must complete a minimum of 42 semester hours of credit in courses numbered 300 or above
- 6. All candidates must complete a minimum of 25 percent of the requirements for graduation at Campbellsville University.
- 7. All candidates must submit a Graduation Application on TigerNet.
- 8. At least one-third of the course requirements in the major and in the minor or area of concentration must be completed at Campbellsville University with an average of "C" or better.
- 9. All candidates for a degree must complete the last 30 hours of credit in residence.
- 10. No more than 32 hours of correspondence and/or extension work will be accepted for credit toward the degree. No student may enroll for correspondence or extension while doing resident work without permission of the Registrar. Correspondence work in major or minor field must be approved also by the Chair of the Divisions concerned.
- 11. The student must, in all cases, be responsible for meeting the requirements for graduation.

## **General Transfer Requirements**

Transfers from KCTCS are eligible for the following scholarships

- Online Students-up to \$1500
- Regional Sites-\$500 Opportunity Scholarship
- Main Campus- \$6000-\$9000 Transfer Scholarship

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
