Individualized Studies Concentration:

The 21 hours can be hours from an existing program/major (that’s not a Liberal Arts and Sciences concentration area) or hours utilized to create a designed concentration area. Designed concentration areas must be approved by either the Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences (for students pursuing the program on-campus) or the Dean of Regional Instruction (for students pursuing the program at regional centers) or the Vice President for Academic Affairs.

Choose seven courses, 3 courses must be upper division: 21 Hours

Electives: 58 Hours

Choose any courses from any college or school that are not used to meet other program requirements. Of the 58 hours, 33 hours must be upper division (level 300-400). No D grades will be allowed in the area.
