Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the Associates in Arts at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and leads to the Bachelor of Science, P-12 Learning and Behavior Disorders at Campbellsville University.

Admission to Campbellsville University is not the same as admission to the School of Education. We have a Candidate Assessment Program (CAP) which involves four steps. You must complete the first two prior to being admitted into the School of Education.

Primary requirements for admission to the School of Education include a 2.75 GPA, a CAP 2 video, and evidence of academic competency. You must have a C or better in ENG 111, 112, and MAC 120/140. You must demonstrate academic competency in the following ways:

The ACT with a composite score of 22 OR the corresponding minimum scores:

-Reading - 20 -English1 - 18 -Math-19

OR

The Praxis Core Academic Skills for Educators (CASE) with the corresponding minimum scores:

- CASE Reading (5713)- 156
- CASE Writing (5723)- 162
- CASE Mathematics (5733) 150

OR

You may use a combination of ACT and CASE minimum scores to meet the requirements above.

If you have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale, you can demonstrate academic competency with the following Praxis CASE scores: -Reading (5713)-151; -Writing (5723)- 157; and -Mathematics (5733)- 145
